



Rules for Camp Mary Orton Rental Guests:

- ~ **Respect Camp Mary Orton property.** Our environment is important to us!
- ~ Parking is permitted in designated areas only. There is a ten-minute parking limit in front of the Lodge for unloading and loading purposes only; this is a NO PARKING zone.
- ~ All set up and clean up for rental groups is the responsibility of the rental group. This includes the clean up of grounds, the parking lot, the Lodge, kitchen, and any other areas used by your group.
- ~ All trash should be placed in the dumpsters and recyclables disposed in the recyclable dumpster.
Please do not litter.
- ~ There is **no smoking** allowed inside the Lodge or any other camp building. Smoking must be done in designated areas and all cigarette butts thrown away in proper receptacles.
- ~ All Camp Mary Orton equipment (tables, chairs, picnic tables, sporting equipment, etc..) has a proper storage location and should be returned to that location as part of your rental cleanup. Please refer to your host if you need direction.
- ~ A Camp Mary Orton rental host will be on-duty for your rental. Hosts provide answers to questions, assistance & direction with set up/clean up, operation of our electric golf carts, and enforcement of Camp Mary Orton safety & rental rules. If a host does a good job, please let us know; tips are not expected, but are always appreciated. If you have an issue with a host, please contact your rental services consultant at the main Camp office during regular business hours: Monday-Friday 9A-5P.
- ~ Any damage to the property or injuries must be reported to the host. Hosts are trained in CPR-First Aid and will determine if emergency personnel should be called. You may be assessed a fee for damages to property or equipment as a result of your rental and/or guests.
- ~ The use of the pool is at the discretion of the Camp Mary Orton lifeguard. Not following lifeguard direction or CMO pool safety rules could result in the pool being closed to your rental party. Refer to the pool rules on the opposite side of this document. **Do not enter the pool area without a Camp Mary Orton lifeguard on duty.**
- ~ **Do not enter** the property of the Leadership and Challenge Center without Camp Mary Orton staff. This area is not included in the rental agreement. If you have arranged to participate in LCC activities as part of your rental, staff will escort/direct you where to go.
- ~ Camp Mary Orton is open for the time contracted in your rental agreement. **Additional hours must be pre-arranged** with the rental services staff. The host will ask you to leave at the time indicated on your contract.
- ~ Although we seem removed from the city, neighborhood environments are very close. Music must be played at a respectful level and stopped or turned down at 10pm.

Rules for Camp Mary Orton Rental Guests (CONT.)

- ~ **Illegal behavior on Camp Mary Orton property will not be tolerated.** (i.e. public intoxication, drug use, underage drinking, fireworks, vandalism, public lewd acts) . One person's inappropriate behavior or choices can result in the entire group being asked to vacate the premises and the proper authorities being notified.
- ~ **Parents are responsible for the activities and behavior of their minor-aged children.** All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult while at the pool, on the playground, in the woods or on the hiking trails or around a campfire.
- ~ Fires are only permitted in designated fire rings or the lodge fireplace with the supervision of your host.
- ~ **Camp Mary Orton is private property.** We can ask anyone to leave at anytime for any reason if it is determined that behavior or actions are destructive to our property, programming, or guests. Please conduct yourself in a manner that is safe, courteous and respectful.
- ~ Camp Mary Orton is a WEAPON FREE ZONE. All weapons and firearms, including concealed firearms, are prohibited on the premises. Hunting is never allowed on our property.

Pool Rules for Camp Mary Orton Rental Guests:

- Only Camp Mary Orton vetted lifeguards are allowed.
- Guests do not enter the pool area without the CMO lifeguard.
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by a parent.
- No eating or drinking in pool area.
- No glass containers allowed in pool area.
- No alcohol in the pool area.
- No running in pool area.
- No diving ~ No flips.
- Do not sit, stand, or hang on the rope.
- No profanity.
- No splashing the lifeguard.
- No horseplay, dunking or throwing people into the pool allowed.
- Pool toys allowed at lifeguard's discretion.
- No shoes, cut-off jeans or jewelry in the pool.
- No swimming after dark.
- Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- Anyone not listening to the CMO lifeguard will be asked to leave the pool area.
- The CMO lifeguard will close down the pool if rules are not being followed.
- Anyone attempting to enter the pool when it is locked will be asked to leave the premises.
